Windows of Woodbury: City Update

The Woodbury City Council recently approved the following developments:

All World Pickleball is a new indoor 15-court, 45,000 square-foot pickleball facility, located at 11650 Hudson Road (1/2 mile west of Manning Avenue) in the Northeast Business Park. The new business will open this fall.

Hope Breakfast Bar is putting the finishing touches on their leasehold improvements at 1930 Donegal Drive, Suite 100. They plan to open in early July.

Public Lands is the newest retail tenant in Woodbury Lakes, selling a wide array of outdoor recreation apparel, accessories, gear and equipment. They opened in June and are located in the former BuyBuy Baby location.



Nikki Rohloff Invited to White House


The Chamber will be collecting baby shampoo, lotion and diaper cream at networking events through the Fall as part of its Charitable Foundation giving opportunity for members.


